



Golf Canada Level 1 Rules Education and Certification for HHJGT

In 2017 the HHJGT announced a change in our policy that we feel will improve the experience for all players in the future. The rules and etiquette of our game are a foundation of our tour and we have found that the level of rules understanding amongst our members has a tendency to negatively effect pace of play and competitors awareness of rules infractions by them and/or fellow competitors. As a result, all new HHJGT members are required to complete Golf Canada Level 1 Rules seminar and certification prior to Tour Stop #2 of each tour season. Here is the information to access the Golf Canada Rules curriculum:

How to Complete Level 1 Rules of Golf Training for HHJGT Players

Visit the Golf Canada website, www.golfcanada.ca and select Rules Education at the bottom of the webpage or go directly there <http://golfcanada.ca/rules-of-golf/#rules-education>.

Select "Start Level 1 Now".

Register (for new users). Registration involves creating a new account over 5 steps:

1. Fill out the New Account form with your details.
2. An email will be immediately sent to your email address.
3. Read your email, and click on the web link it contains.
4. Your account will be confirmed and you will be logged in.
5. Now, select the course you want to participate in.

During the registration process, you will be asked choose a username and password (at least 4 characters) as well as to provide mandatory and optional details to Golf Canada about yourself such as your email address, first and last names, city/town, country, etc. To be certified at Level 1, which you must be, provide additional mandatory and optional details such as your address, postal code, province, date of birth, phone number, club affiliation (if you are a club member or GO public player) and Golf Ontario/Golf Canada Card Number (10 digit number on the front of the card beside the word MEMBER). You will also be asked to answer a security question to prove you are a human being as opposed to a web bot.

Login (for returning users with an existing username and password) using your username and password.

Complete all the required components (i.e. lessons, practice exam, final exam) and access via download or purchase the available resources (i.e. definitions, Rules Book, Decisions Book). You may choose to "Ask an Expert" on the Rules of Golf if you are still not certain about something.

Upon successfully completing the final exam, Golf Canada will let the tour know that you have completed Level 1 Rules training, as well as emailing you a certificate of completion and telling you how to become more involved in the game of golf. Please follow up with the HHJGT, to confirm the completion of the Golf Canada Rules Level 1 certification by emailing a copy of your Level 1 Rules certification using info@hhjgt.com or bring a copy of your Level 1 Rules certification with you to the player registration table by no later than the start of the 2nd event at the Glendale Golf and Curling Club on July 14, 2018. ***Without proof of certification and completion of Golf Canada Rules Level 1, you will not be permitted to continue to compete on the HHJGT.***
